The "Baby" Christian Action Plan



A "baby" Christian believes in God but doesn't have a close relationship with Him. It might be new, or they just never really "felt" it.

Important Steps to Take:

- Find a "prayer warrior" who can pray with you daily.
- Get to know who God is and who you are to Him by reading His Word.
- Stop thinking about your loved one and think about the One who loves you!

Your Verses to Read Daily:

"The Lord your God is in your midst, A victorious warrior. He will exult over you with joy, He will be quiet in His love, He will rejoice over you with shouts of joy." -Zephaniah 3:17

"And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love." -Romans 8:38-39

"But now, this is what the Lord says...Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine." -Isaiah 43:1

**Don't worry about trusting God right now, focus on getting to know Him.*

The "Teenage" Christian Action Plan



The "teenage" Christian has a relationship with God and they're just starting to find out who God really is. They're usually really excited about it!

Important Steps to Take:

- Pray for personal protection.
- Focus on blindly trusting God to handle your situation.
- Keep the atmosphere of your home happy and hopeful with worship music, Christian movies and books that encourage you in your faith.

Your Verses to Read Daily:

"Do not be afraid of them; the Lord your God himself will fight for you." -Deuteronomy 3:22

"The Lord your God is in your midst, A victorious warrior. He will exult over you with joy, He will be quiet in His love, He will rejoice over you with shouts of joy." -Zephaniah 3:17

"He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."...He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart. You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day, nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday. A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you...For he will command his angels concerning you, to guard you in all your ways..."Because he loves me," says the Lord, "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name. He will call upon me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honour him..."

The "Adult" Christian Action Plan



The "adult" Christian has a relationship with God. You're friends. You might have been baptized in the Holy Spirit. You may have some spiritual gifts working in your life, but you desire to go deeper.

Important Steps to Take:

- Reach out and help someone else in love to drive the spirit of fear out of your life.
- Seek out a mentor who can help you grow in faith and let go of baggage.
- Focus on hearing God's voice and what He wants you to know in this season.

Your Verses to Read Daily:

"Tell everyone who is discouraged, Be strong and don't be afraid! God is coming to your rescue..." -Isaiah 35:4

"The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear him, and he delivers them." -
Psalm 34:7

"But even if you suffer for doing what is right, God will reward you for it. So don't worry or be afraid of their threats." -1 Peter 3:14

**Don't allow "works" to take precedence over your relationship.*

The "Senior" Christian Action Plan



The "senior" Christian has been baptized in the Holy Spirit and has an intimate, close relationship with God, deeper than the one they have with their spouse or any other close relationship in their lives. They hear God's voice clearly and follow Him intending to live in deepening righteousness.

Important Steps to Take:

- Pray warfare prayers or reach out to someone called to intercession to pray with you.
- Stay in a very intimate, vulnerable place with God daily.
- Pay close attention to what/where the Holy Spirit is telling you to say/go/do, God may have a surprise in store for you. Follow Him without fear.

Your Verses to Read Daily:

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." -Philippians 4:6-7

"Cast your cares on the Lord and he will sustain you; he will never let the righteous fall." -
Psalm 55:22

"Very truly I tell you, whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and they will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father. And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it." -John 14:12-14
